## 10. ASEP -

- a. Spring ASEP
  - 200 registrants (compared to 195 in winter & 213 in fall). 300 total classes
- b. Summer Camp
  - Flex Academies
  - Weekly sessions running from June 18 July 27. No camp the week of July 4
  - Full day, half day, extended care, lunch options
  - Teachers can apply to be camp counselors and/or camp director
  - MTES PTA takes 10% of gross income
  - Registration is open through early June
  - All weeks have met minimum capacity total as of 4/5 78 registrants (about \$1300 for PTA)
- b. ASEP 2018-2019
  - Flex Academies will run the entire program for 15% of tuition.
    - Includes
      - Processing credit cards
      - Paying all vendors including teachers
      - Negotiating contracts with vendors & payment terms with teachers
      - Onsite coordinator; no more volunteers (no free classes)
      - Communications sent out to parents every week
